Power Department–Total Electrification Project- Electrification of all the households in the State by March -2017 for an estimated amount of ₹. 174 Crore -Administrative Sanction – accorded - orders issued.

ORDER

The Government of Kerala has decided to electrify all the households in the State by March 2017. It is expected that nearly 1,30,000 households in the State will be electrified under the scheme during this financial year about 40,000/- SC households and 20,000 ST households will be benefited. Among this around 2250 households have to be electrified using DDG -Microgrid solutions. Out of this M/s Energy Management Centre (EMC) will be carrying out DDG projects for Electrifying households in 3 colonies (viz. Alampetty, Eechampetty, Thayanamkudy) under Devikulam Constituencies in Idukki District, M/s ANERT will be implementing remaining DDG projects in Idukki District and also projects in Palakkadu and Wayanad District (total 60 colonies) and KSEB will implement DDG/Micro Grid Projects in remaining districts (total 23 colonies).

2. The Chairman and Managing Director, KSEB Ltd in the letter read above has reported that the total project cost for total electrification is estimated to be ₹. 174 Cr of this KSEB Ltd will meet ₹. 63.82 Crore (50% of the estimated cost of electrification of each LA Constituency, subject to a maximum of Rupees One Crore per Constituency). The balance funding is expected to be met from other sources as detailed below:


